Cirque de la Symphonie is designed to bring the magic of cirque to the music hall, showcasing many of the best cirque artists in the world. They include world record holders, gold-medal winners of international competitions, Olympians, and some of the most original talent ever seen.

Alexander Streltsov is a Russian aerial artist who, at age 12, started working with future Cirque du Soleil choreographer Pavel Brun and famed producer Valentin Gneushev, performing on Broadway at the Gershwin Theater.

The dynamic and exciting balancing act **Jarek and Darek** consists of Jaroslaw Marciniak and Dariusz Wronski, former Polish national hand-balancing champions.

Aloysia Gavre is another incredible aerial performer from the École National de Cirque in Montréal, with early training from Master Lu-Yi and the Pickle Family Circus School.

Vladimir Tsarkov provides a spellbinding performance with combinations of mime and juggling feats.

Christine Van Loo is a seven-time consecutive National Champion, Female Olympic Athlete of the Year, and Athlete of the Decade in acrobatic gymnastics.

Irina Burdetsky grew up in a circus family in Moscow; was trained by some of the greatest names in acrobatics, gymnastics, and hoops; and traveled as one of the youngest performers with the Moscow Circus.

Elena Tsarkova, the “Lady in White,” is a graduate of the famed Moscow Circus School and first-place winner of the prestigious National Russian Circus Festival.
